

College Articulation Agreements for Montgomery County Public Schools' Students Brochure

Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) has created the *College Articulation Agreements for Montgomery County Public Schools' Students* brochure to describe the process of how students can earn **FREE** College Tech Prep credits at Montgomery College (MC) and several other colleges. The brochure lists the 11 MCPS career clusters:

- Arts, Humanities, Media, and Communications (careers in TV and radio broadcasting, printing, and interactive media)
- Biosciences, Health Science, and Medicine (careers in medical careers, biotechnology, nursing, and biomedical)
- Business Management and Finance (careers in accounting, business administration and management, finance, and marketing)
- Construction and Development (careers in carpentry, electricity, heating and air conditioning, masonry, and plumbing)
- Education, Training, and Child Studies (careers in teaching)
- Engineering, Scientific Research, and Manufacturing Technologies (careers in engineering)
- Environmental, Agricultural, and Natural Resources (careers in environmental science and policy, horticulture, and landscape technology and management)
- Human and Consumer Services, Hospitality, and Tourism (careers in food and beverage preparation and management, hospitality and restaurant management)
- Information Technology (careers in programming, network, database administration and wireless technologies, and website development)
- Law, Government, Public Safety, and Administration (careers in fire and rescue services, law, criminal justice, and criminology)
- Transportation, Distribution, and Logistics (careers in automotive technologies)

The brochure also includes the respective career pathway programs at MCPS and the corresponding colleges. After reading this brochure, parents and students will understand how MCPS courses and career pathway programs articulate to courses and programs at MC. Students who take advantage of the articulation process can earn up to 24 **FREE** college tech prep credits. The savings in time and tuition can easily be likened to a college scholarship.
